CLUSTERED PEARL STRETCH BRACELET

Materials

- 48 3mm Freshwater Pearls 8 6x4mm Crystal ab SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS Oval 5200
- Beadalon Satin Silver Elasticity 215A-020
- Beadalon Bead Stringing Glue

Tools

- Beadalon Knotter Tool
- Scissors

1. Cut off a 15" segment of cord. Starting 1.5" from end, tie on your first pearl by stringing on the cord, tying an overhand knot and pulling tight.
2. Add a second pearl on the wire, knot with knotter tool, pulling it flush to the first pearl. Continue making a cluster of six pearls.
3. Thread on a bead.

4. Continue this pattern for a total of six clusters and six beads.

5. When you reach the final bead, tie a double overhand knot with the ends, pulling bracelet together. I like to tie two knots.

6. Add a dab of bead stringing glue and allow to dry overnight. Snip off cord ends flush to knot.
