

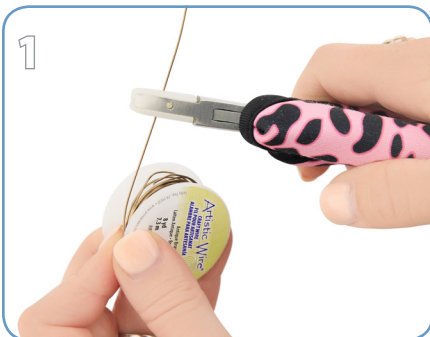
BIRD'S NEST PENDANT

Materials

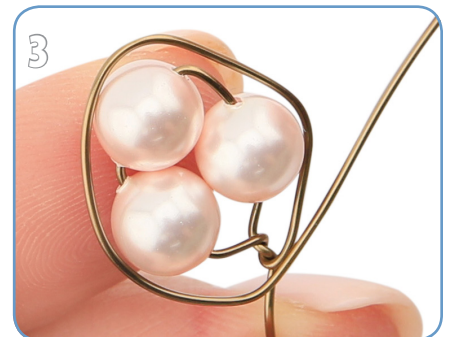
- AWD-22-24-08YD- 22 GA ANTIQUE BRASS ARTISTIC WIRE
- FAUX SUEDE LACE
- 356R-010 ANTIQUE BRASS JUMP RINGS
- 1-4 OR MORE BEADS
- CHARMS AND COMPONENTS



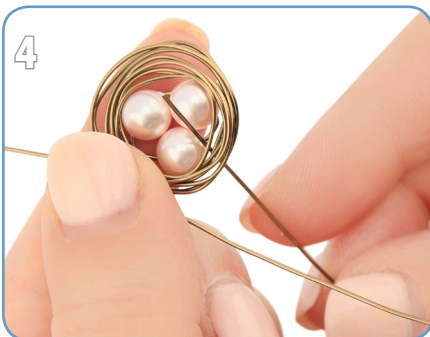
1. Working from the spool, straighten a two foot length of 22 gauge Artistic Wire with Nylon Jaw Pliers.



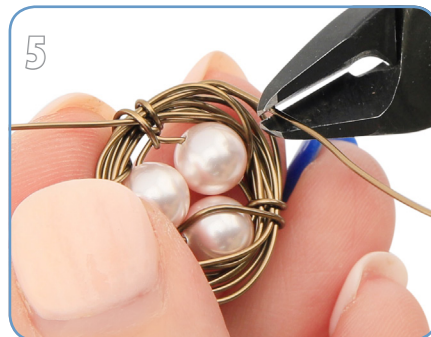
2. String your beads on the end of the Wire, leaving about three inches, and bend them into a triangle.



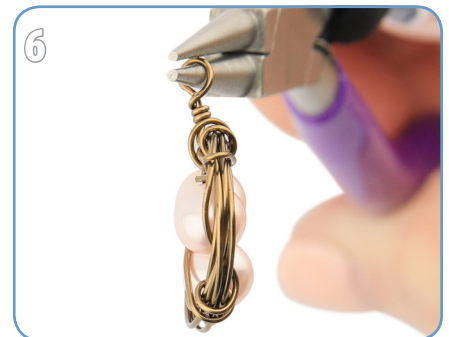
3. Holding the beads in your thumb and forefinger, turn the beads to wrap the wire loosely around the beads.



4. When you have enough wraps, pull out about 18 additional inches of Wire, and cut it from the spool. Wrap the end of the Wire through and around the nest 3-4 times to secure.



5. Trim the excess Wire and tuck in the end.



6. Turn a wrapped loop on top with the excess wire. Use jump rings to attach charms and 22 gauge wire to make a bail and attach a length of Suede Lace.
