

## DESIGN WORKSHOP

### BEACHY KEEN BRACELET

### Materials

- *Beadalon Materials:*
- \*3 StoneSett, Silver Plated Swoosh Drops – 351B-112
- \*3 Round, White, Brilliant Cut Cubic Zirconia – 505Z-050
- \*50 6mm Silver Color Jump Rings – 314B-005
- \*1 4mm Silver Color Jump Ring – 314B-003
- \*1 3mm Silver Color Jump Ring – 314B-002
- \*1 Silver Color Lobster Clasp – 315B-003
- \*2 #1 Silver Color Crimp Beads – JFC1S-1Z
- \*2 Silver Color Wire Guardians – 325B-010
- \*2 3mm Silver Color Crimp Bead Covers – 349B-008
- \*Beadalon 49 Strand Stringing Wire, Bright – JW22T-0

#### *Beadalon Tools:*

- \*Designer Sparkle Chain Nose Pliers – 201A-101
- \*Designer Flush Cutter – 202E-001

1. Using the instructions provided with your StoneSett, create 3 Swoosh drops.
2. Using chain nose pliers, attach a 6mm silver color jump ring to each drop. Set aside.
3. Using chain nose pliers, attach a 6mm silver color jump ring to 4 starfish charms. Set aside.
4. Using the flush cutter, cut a 10" section of Beadalon 49 Strand Bright Stringing Wire.
5. Thread a #1 crimp bead onto the wire.
6. Thread the end of the wire through a silver color wire guardian and back through the crimp bead.
7. Place the crimp bead into the first station of the crimper tool (closest to the handle). Using your fingers to ensure the wires sit side by side within the bead, gently squeeze the crimper tool closed over the crimp bead.
8. Place the crimp bead into the second station of the crimper tool (furthest from the handle). Gently squeeze the crimper tool closed over the bead, creating a nicely formed "U" shape.
9. Using the flush cutter, trim the tail of the wire as close to the crimp bead as possible.



10. With the rounded portion of the crimper tool, close a crimp bead cover over the crimp bead.
11. Thread on 6 freshwater pearls.
12. Thread on 6 6mm silver color jump rings.
13. Thread on a starfish charm.
14. Continue threading on jump rings and alternating Swoosh drops and starfish charms, separated by 5 jump rings.
15. Thread on the last 6 jump rings before adding the last beads.
16. Thread on the six remaining freshwater pearls.
17. Repeat steps 5-10 to complete the strand.
18. Using chain nose pliers, attach a 6mm jump ring to one of the wire guardians on the end of the strand.
19. On the opposite end of the strand, attach a 3mm jump ring to the wire guardian.
20. Before closing the jump ring, thread on the silver color lobster clasp. Close the jump ring.
