## **DESIGN WORKSHOP**

### BLUE TASSEL CHOKER By: Sara Ellis



- 1. Following the instructions included with the Tassel Maker, create 6 large tassel loops with Blue and Black tassel thread (approximately 35 wraps). Do not cut the tassel loops in half. Finish the tassels with 6mm Jump Rings. Set aside.
- 2. Using the Flush Cutter, cut two sections of Cable Chain that are approximately 4.5" long 56 links total on each strand.
- 3. Thread a 6mm Bicone onto a head pin. (BC2.jpg)
- 4. Thread the head pin through the 8th link of one of your sections of chain. \*Note in the photos, the first 8 links of chain have been removed, so it will appear as though the head pin is threaded through the first link of chain.\*
- 5. Thread a 14mm Round Glass Bead onto the head pin.
- 6. Thread the 8th link of chain on the second cut section of chain onto the head pin.
- 7. Thread a 6mm Bicone onto the head pin.
- 8. Using Nose Pliers, bend the head pin 90 degrees at the top of the Bicone.
- 9. Using the Flush Cutter, trim the wire, leaving approximately  $\frac{1}{2}$ " of wire.

### **Materials**

- 2 6.5" sections of Medium Silver Color Oval Link Pattern Chain – 340B-112
- Small Silver Color Cable Chain 340B-001
- Medium Silver Color EZ Lobster Clasp 315B-220
- 6 Silver Color Head Pins 312B-113
- 8 6mm Silver Color Jump Rings 314B-005
- 6 4mm Silver Color Jump Rings 314B-003
- 6 14mm Round Glass Beads
- 6 8mm Crystal Rondelles
- 12 4mm Crystal Bicones
- Tools
- Tassel Maker 216S-100
- Beadstrom Chain Nose Pliers 201P-011
- Beadstrom Round Nose Pliers 201P-014
- Designer Flush Cutter 202E-001
- Designer Beading Scissors 211A-002
- Bead Stringing Glue 215A-020







- 10. Using Round Nose Pliers, grasp the end of the wire and roll the wire back towards the beads, creating a closed loop. (BC9.jpg)
- 11. Repeat Steps 3-10 five additional times, spacing the beads 8 chain links apart.



- 12. Using Chain Nose Pliers, attach a 4mm Jump Ring to the 6mm Jump Rings on the tops of each tassel.
- 13. Before closing the Jump Rings, thread the 4mm Jump Ring through the closed loop at the 6mm Bicones on the beaded chain. Close the Jump Rings.
- 14. Using Chain Nose Pliers, open a 6mm Jump Ring. Thread the 6mm Jump Ring through the last links of each section of chain on one end of the beaded chain. Close the Jump Ring.
- 15. Repeat Step 14 on the opposite end of the beaded chain.
- 16. Using Chain Nose Pliers, open the last link of one of the 6.5" Oval Pattern Chain sections. Thread the link through one of the 6mm Jump Rings that you just added. Close the link.
- 17. Repeat Step 16 on the opposite side of the beaded chain with the other 6.5" section of Oval Pattern Chain.
- 18. Using Chain Nose Pliers, attach the EZ Lobster Clasp to one end of the Oval Pattern Chain Sections.
- 19. The finished necklace should look similar to this image 19.
