SUMMER LAKE BRACELET

Materials

1. Follow the instructions included with the Artistic Findings Form Toggle to create a gold colored toggle with 22 Gauge Artistic Wire. Set aside.



2. Cut approximately 6" of Beadalon 19 Strand Satin Gold Stringing Wire with the flush cutter.

- 3. Thread a #1 gold color crimp bead onto the wire.
- 4. Loop the wire over a 3mm gold color jump ring and back through the crimp bead, leaving a short tail. Position the crimp bead as close to the jump ring as possible, leaving a small loop.
- 5. Using the crimper tool, place the crimp bead inside the first station of the crimper tool (closest to the handle). Position the wires side by side within the bead and gently close the crimper over the bead. This will separate the wires within the crimp bead.

- 6. Move the crimp bead into the second station of the crimper tool (furthest from the handle) and gently squeeze the crimper tool, creating a nicely shaped "U".
- 7. Trim the tail of the wire as close to the crimp bead as possible.
- 8. Using the curved section of the crimper tool, close a gold color crimp bead cover over the crimp bead.
- 9. Thread on 9 turquoise and brown rondell beads, alternating with metal daisy beads.
- 10. Repeat Steps 3-7 to finish the strand. Both ends should match; ending in a crimp covered by a crimp cover and a 3mm jump ring. Set aside.
- 11. Thread a gold color bead cap, turquoise and brown rondelle and another bead cap onto a gold color eye pin.



- 12. Using chain nose pliers, bend the wire 90 degrees.
- 13. Trim the wire with the flush cutter, leaving approximately 1/2".
- 14. Using round nose pliers, grasp the end of the wire and roll the wire back towards the bead, creating a closed loop.
- 15. Repeat Steps 11-14 to create a second wire wrapped bead link.
- 16. Repeat Steps 11-14, using a head pin, to create a wire wrapped bead with a single loop. Set aside.
- 17. Using chain nose pliers, open the jump ring on one end of the beaded strand. Thread a gold/aqua connector onto the jump ring and close.
- 18. Using chain nose pliers, continue connecting the 2 wire wrapped bead links and 2 remaining connectors together with 3mm jump rings in between.

19. Using chain nose pliers, attach a 3mm jump ring to the last connector in the strand. Before closing the jump ring, add the loop section of the toggle clasp (attaching at the smallest loop)



- 20. Open the jump ring at the opposite end of the beaded strand with chain nose pliers. Thread on the toggle bar portion of your toggle clasp. Close the jump ring.
- 21. Using chain nose pliers, attach a 3mm jump ring to the metal swallow charm. Close the jump ring.
- 22. Using chain nose pliers, attach the jump ring containing the swallow charm to a 4mm gold color jump ring. Before closing the jump ring, thread the jump ring through the last jump ring before the toggle on the bracelet. Leave the jump ring open and gently set aside.
- 23. Using chain nose pliers, attach 2 3mm jump rings to the unused single loop beaded link.
- 24. Thread the top jump ring from the previous step onto the open 4mm jump ring on the bracelet. Using chain nose pliers, close the jump ring.
