TRIANGLE QUICK LINKS BRACELET By: Sara Ellis



- 1. Using the Designer Beading Scissors, cut approximately 10 12 inch sections of Black Poly Sparkle thread and No.6 Black Silk Cord. Place the sections together in a bunch.
- 2. Using Chain Nose Pliers, open a 6mm Jump Ring and thread it through the 20mm Quick Link. Close the Jump Ring.
- 3. Thread the sections of Black Poly Sparkle and Silk Cord through the Jump Ring. Position the Jump Ring in the middle of the strands.
- 4. Refer to the instructions included with the Tying Station. Place the Quick Link over the post on the Tying Station.
- 5. Replace the plate and tighten the wing nut.
- 6. Separate the Silk Cord and Poly Sparkle Threads into three sections.
- 7. Create a 3.5 inch three-strand braid with the sections.
- 8. Remove the braided section from the Tying Station.
- 9. Cut a 6 inch strand of Black Poly Sparkle Thread with the Designer Beading Scissors.

Materials

- 8 Silver Tone, Triangle, Diamond Cut Quick Links – 314B-396
- 15 6mm Silver Tone Jump Rings 314B-005
- Medium Silver Tone EZ Lobster Clasp 315B-220
- Black Poly Sparkle Thread 130U-010
- No.6 Black Silk Cord JH06S-BLACK-C
- 20mm Silver Tone Round Quick Link 314B-318
- 4 14X14X14mm Crystal Volcano, Swarovski, Faceted Cosmic Triangles
- Taala
- Beadstrom Chain Nose Pliers 201P-011
- Designer Beading Scissors 211A-002
 - Tying Station 216S-210









- 10. Tie a double knot with the Black Poly Sparkle Thread at the end of the braided section.
- 11. Make several wraps with the Poly Sparkle Thread to secure the thread bundles.
- 12. Tie a double knot with the ends of the thread, snugging the knot down to the surface of the threads. *OPTIONAL add a dab of glue to the knot.
- 13. Using the Designer Beading Scissors, trim the ends of the braid to create the desired shape.
- 14. Using Chain Nose Pliers, remove the Quick Link from the 6mm Jump Ring by opening the Jump Ring.
- 15. Before closing the Jump Ring, thread a Triangle Quick Link onto the Jump Ring. Close the Jump Ring.
- 16. Using Chain Nose Pliers, open a 6mm Jump Ring and carefully thread the Jump Ring through the wrapped section at the end of the braid. Close the Jump Ring. Set aside.
- 17. Using Chain Nose Pliers, open a 6mm Jump Ring and thread on a Triangle Quick Link. Close the Jump Ring.
- 18. Create a 5 triangle strand, adding Jump Rings and alternating Triangle Quick Links and Cosmic Triangles with the Chain Nose Pliers. The strand should contain 2 Cosmic Triangles and end in a Triangle Quick Link.
- 19. Attach a 6mm Jump Ring to the last Quick Link Triangle, using Chain Nose Pliers.
- 20. Repeat Steps 17-19 to create a second triangle strand. Set both aside.
- 21. Using Chain Nose Pliers, attach the EZ Lobster Clasp to a Triangle Quick Link with a 6mm Jump Ring.
- 22. Open the 6mm Jump Rings at the ends of the triangle strands and attach them to the Triangle Quick Link with the EZ Lobster Clasp that you just created. Close the Jump Rings.
- 23. Open the 6mm Jump Rings at the opposite ends of the triangle strands, using Chain Nose Pliers, and attach them to the Triangle Quick Link at the end of the braided strands. Close the Jump Rings. (TQ16.jpg)
- 24. The finished bracelet should look similar to the image on page 1.

8 Gold Color, Triangle, Diamond Cut Quick Links – 314A-396 15 6mm Gold Color Jump Rings – 314A-005 Medium Gold Color EZ Lobster Clasp – 315A-220
