

FRINGY EARRINGS

Supplies

Materials:

- Quick Links Rings
- .012 19 Strand Beadalon Bead Stringing Wire
- Size 1 Crimp Tubes
- Earwires
- 3 colors of Size 11 Seed Beads

Tools:

- Micro Crimping Pliers
- Nipper

Instructions

STEP 1

Chose your QuickLink shape, and decide on your color palette and pattern.

STEP 2

Cut a piece of Bead Stringing Wire about a foot long. Pick up a Size 1 crimp tube. Loop the wire around the QuickLink and back through the crimp tube. Leave about 1/4 inch loo[and crimp the crimp tube in place. Snip the tail flush with the crimp tube.

STEP 3

Thread your pattern of seed beads onto the beading wire. Add one crimp tube and three seed beads. Skip the three seed beads and pass back through the crimp tube, and several of the seed beads. Pull the slack, but not too tight that the wire gets bent out of shape. Use the Micro Crimping Pliers to crimp the tube into place. Trim the end. Repeat steps 2 and 3 until you have as many dangles as you'd like.

STEP 4

Add your earwire. Make a second earring to match the first.
