STEP 1

Measure out 3.5 coils of memory wire and turn a loop in one end.

STEP 2

String on an alternating pattern of one seed bead and one 6mm citrine bead until you have used all of the citrine beads.

STEP 3

Turn a loop on the other end of the memory wire to hold all of the beads in place.

STEP 4 – make the acorns

Use the Alcohol ink with the applicator tool to color the metal bead caps.

STEP 5 - Make 2

Cut about a 3 inch (7.6 cm) length of 24 gauge wire and make a knotted head pin. Thread onto the head pin: one small wooden bead, one 25mm wooden bead, one bead cap. Turn a wrapped loop at the top of the bead cap.

STEP 6

Open a jump ring and pick up one leaf and attach it to the loop on one end of the memory wire. Repeat to add one acorn, one leaf, one acorn and one leaf.
