

JEWELRY MAKING 106: MAKING A LARIAT WITH THE KNOTTER TOOL



Materials

- Beadalon® Silk Thread, Size 6 (Item # 10390143)
- Beadalon G-S Hypo Cement® (Item # 10332390)
- Bead Gallery® Pink Quartzite Round Beads, 6mm (Item # 10321776) - 2
- Bead Gallery® Silver Rhinestone Studded Rondel Beads, 7mm (Item # 10472583) - 2
- Bead Landing™ Suede Tassels (Item # 10395127)
- Charmalong™ Gold & Silver Tassel Charms by Bead Landing™ (Item # 10462462)
- Bead Gallery® White Glass Round Beads, 3mm (Item # 10321903)
- Create Your Style™ Swarovski® October Birthstone Charms (Item # 10474385)

TOOLS:

- Beadalon® Knotter Tool (Item # 10443518)
- Scissors
- Straw cut to 1.5"

LEARN THESE JEWELRY MAKING TECHNIQUES:

- How to make knots in between beads using the Beadalon Knotter Tool
- How to use a Bead Board to lay out a jewelry design

Instructions:

STEP 1

Stretch your Silk Cord to take all of the kinks out.

STEP 2

Tie a knot around the Metal Tassel and the Swarovski Charms in the end of the Silk.

STEP 3

Put a dab of glue on the knot and trim the short end.

STEP 4

Thread the straw over the silk. Follow the instructions included with the Knotter Tool to tie a knot at the end of the straw. Remove the straw from the silk.

STEP 5

String on the following pattern: 1x size 11 seed bead, 1x 3mm white glass bead, 1x 6mm pink quartzite round beads, 1x 7mm silver rhinestone studded rondel bead, 1x 6mm pink quartzite round beads, 1x 3mm white glass bead, 1x size 11 seed bead.

STEP 6

Tie a knot against the beads with the Knotter Tool.

STEP 7

Repeat steps 4- 6 until your lariat is the length you want.

STEP 8

Tie the end of the silk cord to a tassel. Put a dab of glue on the knot. Trim the end.
