LEARN THESE JEWELRY MAKING TECHNIQUES:

- How to crimp
- How to make a multistrand illusion bracelet using spacer bars
- How to attach a clasp

STEP 1

Cut 5x 10 in (25cm) strands of wire. Crimp the end of each wire to one spacer bar.

STEP 2

Lay out 5 series of random beads with about 5-6 beads in each series. Vary your size and texture.

STEP 3

Start with the middle strand of beading wire. String on one crimp tube and use the flat nose pliers to flatten the crimp tube about .75 in (2 cm) from the end.

STEP 4

Add one bead and another crimp tube. Flatten the crimp tube against the bead.

STEP 5

Add another crimp tube, leave about .75 in (2 cm) of bare wire, then flatten the crimp tube. Repeat until your beaded portion measures about 6.5 in (16.5 cm). Use another crimp tube to attach the beading wire to the center loop on the other spacer bar.

STEP 6

Working from the middle to the edges, repeat until all 5 strands are made. Feel free to add a seed bead or a larger bead in between the crimped beads so that it moves freely. Stagger your crimped beads so they don't line up right next to each other. Make sure that your strands are the same length as you crimp them.

STEP 7 – add the clasp

Use a jump ring to attach one half of the hook and eye clasp to the spacer bar. Use another jump ring to attach the other half to the other spacer bar.
