

## DAISY CHAIN NECKLACE by Meredith Roddy



Spring is in the air! This whimsical flower necklace brings flower power as a wearable fashion statement.

### SUPPLIES:

- Beadalon® Findings Variety Pack
- Beadalon® WildFire™ Bead Weaving Thread, 008"
- Size 8 seed beads in pink chalk, opaque lemon yellow, purple chalk, and green mix (or colors of your choosing)

### TOOLS:

- Scissors
- Beadalon® Sparkle Chain Nose Pliers
- Beadalon® Jewel Loom Needle

## INSTRUCTIONS

### STEP 1

Cut a 5 foot (1.5 m) length of .008 WildFire. Flatten the tip of the WildFire with chain nose pliers, and thread it onto the needle.

### STEP 2 – ADDING THE LOBSTER CLAW CLASP

Pick up two green seed beads, one lobster claw clasp, two green seed beads, and one pink bead. Leaving about a 3 inch (7.6 cm) tail, thread through the beads and lobster clasp again to form a circle, and tie a square knot. Trim the end of the WildFire.

### STEP 3

Pick up 6 pink seed beads. Pass around and through the pink seed bead from the previous circle to form a new circle. Pick up one yellow seed bead.

### STEP 4

Skip 3 seed beads, and go through the fourth seed bead in the circle. Pass through all of the seed beads in the circle so that your thread is exiting the first bead you went through. Position the yellow bead so that it is in the center of the circle.

### STEP 5

Pick up one green seed bead, one purple seed bead, and one green seed bead. Pass around and through the two beads on the top of the flower to form a circle of 5 beads. Continue through the next two beads around the circle so your thread is exiting from the top purple bead.

### STEP 6

Repeat steps 3-5 alternating colors until your bracelet or necklace is the length you'd like.

### STEP 7 – ADDING THE TAG

Pick up two green beads, the tag, and two green beads. Pass around the circle several times to reinforce. Tie off the thread with several half hitch knots. Trim the excess thread.
