

RAINBOW WRAPPED BRACELET

Materials:

- 22 gauge silver German Style Wire, round
- Findings Variety Pack
- Multicolor Howlite Round Beads, 10mm

Tools:

- Sparkle Chain Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Bent Chain Nose Pliers
- Sparkle Cutter Tool
- Sparkle Round Nose Pliers

Instructions:

- 1. Cut 60 inches of 22 gauge silver German style wire.
- 2. Find the middle of the wire and create a wrapped loop with round nose pliers, do not cut either end of the wires. You will need the length of both pieces for wire wrapping.
- 3. Thread a 10mm bead onto the wire and slide it up against the wire wraps.
- 4. Guide the wrapping wire along the side of the bead and create three wire wraps on the other side of the bead, locking it into place on the wire.
- 5. Repeat this process, adding beads and wire wrapping them into place until you have reached the desired length of the bracelet.
- 6. Create a wrapped loop at the end of the bracelet.
- 7. Using the remaining length of the wire, wrap between each bead in the opposite direction, over the existing wraps, working your way back to the beginning of the bracelet. This will frame each bead with wire on either side.
- 8. When you reach the beginning end of the bracelet, wire wrap around the wraps at the end and trim the tail.
- 9. Using chain nose pliers, attach jump rings and a clasp onto the ends of the bracelet.
