

## ROSE GOLD CHA CHA PENDANT NECKLACE

## **Materials**

- Supplies:
- (JW02SR-0) 7 Strand .015 SilverRose Beading Wire
- (360L-204) Instant Pendant Ball End or Cone End
- (312L-253) Ball Head Pins and (312L-113) Head Pins
- (356L-010) Rose Gold Findings Variety Pack
- (305X-129) Size 2 Crimp Tube Variety Pack
- Tools:
- (JTNJ1) Nylon Jaw Pliers
- (202E-001) Designer Flush Cutter
- Chain Nose Pliers
- Round Nose Pliers
- (JTCRIMP1) Standard Crimping Pliers
- (216S-210) Acrylic Tying Station
- Beads:
- Swarovski 5000 10mm in Rose Gold and Turquoise
- Swarovski 5600 6mm in Blue Zircon
- or beads of your choosing

## **Instructions:**

- 1. Make a variety of wrapped loop dangles using the flat headpins and ball headpins and the Swarovski beads.
- 2. Unscrew the end from the Instant Pendant, and thread the loops onto the Instant Pendant in a random assortment.
- 3. Screw the end of the Instant Pendant back on.
- 4. Cut three lengths of 7 Strand SilverRose Beading Wire 22 inches long.
- 5. Thread all three wires through a copper color Size 2 crimp tube.
- 6. Thread one of the wires around a clasp, then back through the crimp tube. Crimp the crimp tube and trim the short wires.
- 7. Use the extender plate of the Acrylic Tying Station to hold the lobster clasp in place and braid all three wires together until your necklace is about 18 inches long.
- 8. Thread the braided wires through the loop on the Instant Pendant.
- 9. Thread all three wires through a crimp tube.
- 10. Thread one wire around a tag and back through the crimp tube. Tighten down the crimp tube so it's resting against the top of the braided part of the wires.
- 11. Crimp the crimp tube.
- 12. Super simple, simply beautiful!
