# **Beadalon** DESIGN WORKSHOP

### OASIS NECKLACE

## **Materials**

- Beadalon Materials:
- \*Artistic Wire Findings Form
- (Hook and Eye Clasp) 228S-650
- \*22 Gauge Artistic Wire, Tarnish Resistant Silver – AWD-22S-10-08YD
- \*Beadalon 49 Strand Stringing Wire, Bright JW22T-0
- \*4 6mm Silver Color Jump Rings 314B-005
- \*6 3mm Silver Color Jump Rings 314B-003
- \*4 #1 Silver Color Crimp Beads JFC1S-1.5G
- \*1 Silver Color Eye Pin 310B-113 \*Silver Color Medium Curb Chain

1. Follow the instructions included with the Artistic Wire Findings Form to create a hook and eye clasp using 22 gauge tarnish resistant silver Artistic Wire.

2. Using chain nose pliers, attach a silver color 3mm jump ring to the hook portion of the clasp. Set aside.

3. Using chain nose pliers, attach a silver color 3mm and a 6mm silver jump ring to the eye portion of the clasp. Set aside.

4. Cut a 5-7" section of 22 gauge wire with the flush cutter. Using round nose pliers, create a closed loop on one end of the wire.

5. Hold the closed loop within chain nose pliers and create a flat wire spiral by pushing the wire upwards to wrap around the first loop. Adjusting the pliers as you go, continue until you have the desired size for your spiral.

6. When you have all the loops you need, make a 90 degree bend in the wire using chain nose pliers.

7. Using round nose pliers, push the wire up and over the top barrel of the pliers. The end of the wire should be facing down.





8. Reposition the pliers within the loop to finish the loop.

9. Wrap the wire around the straight portion of the wire below your loop 3-4 times. Trim the excess wire with the flush cutter.

10. Using chain nose pliers, attach a 6mm jump ring to the loop of your spiral charm. Set aside.

11. Thread a 2mm silver color bead, a large flower bead and another 2mm silver color bead onto an eye pin. (On9.jpg)

12. Using chain nose pliers, bend the exiting wire 90 degrees.

13. Using the flush cutter, trim the wire, leaving approximately 1/2" of wire remaining.

14. With round nose pliers, grasp the end of the wire and rotate the wire back towards the beads, creating a closed loop. Set aside.

15. Cut a 16" section of Beadalon 49 Strand Bright Stringing Wire using the flush cutter.

16. Thread a #1 crimp bead onto the wire.

17. Loop the wire over a 3mm silver color jump ring and back through the crimp bead, leaving a short tail.

18. Place the crimp bead into the first station of the crimper tool (closest to the handle), using your fingers to make sure the wires sit side by side within the crimp bead. Gently squeeze the crimper tool closed over the bead.

19. Place the crimp bead into the second station of the crimper tool (furthest from the handle). Gently close the crimper tool over the bead, creating a nicely formed "U" shape.

20. Trim the tail of the wire as close to the crimp bead as possible with the flush cutter.

21. Thread 5 round turquoise beads and a silver color metal daisy bead onto the wire.

22. Continue threading beads in this pattern, 5 round beads and a metal daisy spacer, until you have 4 sections of round beads on the wire.

23. Thread another metal daisy bead onto the wire and an oval turquoise bead. Continue threading oval and daisy beads onto the wire, alternating, until you have thread on 11 oval beads.

24. Repeat Steps 16-20 to finish the strand. Set aside.

25. Repeat Steps 16-20 to begin a new wire strand using 12" cut section of Beadalon 49 Strand Bright Stringing Wire.

26. Repeat Steps 21 and 22, rendering 4 sections of round beads separated by metal daisy beads.

27. Thread another metal daisy bead onto the wire and 5 Fiesta Stone beads onto the wire.

28. Thread another metal daisy bead and another 5 Fiesta Stone beads onto the wire.

29. Thread a metal daisy bead onto the wire, followed by a large flower bead and an additional metal daisy bead.

30. Repeat Steps 27 and 28, threading on the remainder the beads.

31. Repeat Steps 16-20 to finish the strand.













32. Using chain nose pliers, open a 6mm jump ring and thread on the 3mm jump rings at the ends of both beaded strands.

33. Before closing the jump ring, thread on one of the loop ends of the previously made flower bead link. Close the jump ring.

34. Place the 6mm jump ring, attached to the spiral charm, over the top of the loop of the flower bead link. Place the spiral flat against the flower bead.

35. Using chain nose pliers, attach the 6mm jump ring, previously added to the eye portion of your clasp, to the top loop of the flower bead link. Set aside.

36. Using the flush cutter, cut a 6" section of curb chain.

37. Using chain nose pliers, open a 6mm jump ring and thread on the 3mm jump rings at the opposite ends of both beaded strands.

38. Before closing the jump ring, thread one end of you chain section onto the jump ring. Close the jump ring.

39. On the opposite end of the chain section, attach the jump ring and hook portion of your clasp.

40. Hook the clasp through the eye portion of the clasp on the opposite side of the necklace to finish the piece. (ON24.jpg)
